

MDCLC- RESOLUTION No. 2020-1

A RESOLUTION OF THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY LEAGUE OF CITIES BOARD OF DIRECTORS STATING THEIR OPPOSITION OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY EMERGENCY ORDER No. 26-20.

WHEREAS, The Miami-Dade County League of Cities Board of Directors is in opposition of closing indoor dining in restaurants as stated in Emergency Order No. 26-20 dated/signed on July 8, 2020; and

WHEREAS the decision to close indoor dining in restaurants as stated in Emergency Order No. 26-20 dated/signed on July 8, 2020 was made without presenting scientific evidence based on a shared set of facts and without consulting the Miami-Dade County League of Cities Board of Directors or the Miami-Dade League of Cities Mayor's Coalition; and

WHEREAS elected officials from the 34 municipalities in Miami-Dade County should be part of the decision-making process when issuing an order like Emergency Order 26-20


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY LEAGUE OF CITIES BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY LEAGUE OF CITIES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
