THE RESOLUTION OF THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY LEAGUE OF CITIES, INC., THROUGH ITS BOARD OF DIRECTORS, AND MAYOR'S COALITION WILL DESIGNATE FORMER LEAGUE PRESIDENT AND CITY OF MIAMI MAYOR, FRANCIS SUAREZ, AS ITS REPRESENTATIVE IN THE DISCUSSIONS WITH GOVERNOR DE SANTIS ON LOCAL INITIATIVES TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19.

WHEREAS, Universal mask wearing prevents lockdowns. Increasing universal masking by 15% could prevent the need for lockdowns and reduce associated losses of up to \$1 trillion or about 5% of gross domestic product.

WHEREAS, Wearing masks in non-health care settings reduces the risk of infection about 40-70%, and the benefit is greater when there is community-wide wearing.

WHEREAS, Universal mask wearing in community decreases new infections in communities.

WHEREAS, Universal mask wearing in a community decreases mortality in communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MIAMI DADE COUNTY LEAGUE CITIES INC.:

Section 1. That the Honorable Francis Suarez, Mayor of the City of Miami is hereby appointed as the League representative in the discussions with Governor De Santis on local initiatives to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
